



## “God’s Greatest Revelation to You”

### *Exodus 3*

#### **V. 5 – “for the place on which you are standing is holy ground”**

The ground was not holy before this. Moses never knew of this area as “sacred” before this experience

So what made this area “holy” all of a sudden?

The fact that God’s presence was manifested there at this point & time!

At Prairie Springs, people thought it was goofy that a church would meet and worship at a middle school or a strip mall.

People thought it odd that we started worshipping above a retail store.

God’s manifest presence makes it sacred, not a fancy building. That’s why we call this our “Worship Center”. It isn’t a church. It’s a building that we use to meet in, we are the church!!

People used to ask: “When are you going to build a church?”

We already are! We are building up a body of believers!!

“I AM...”

God let Moses know upfront that it was Him.

“I AM the God of your father...”

Next, God tells Moses that He is the God of his father

Amram = Wicked and pious man

“I AM the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob”

He is telling Moses something very important here... He is the God of the wicked, and the God of the righteous!

Isaiah 43:13 (NLT) – “From eternity to eternity, I Am God.

No one can oppose what I do. No one can reverse My actions.”

*God is still in Control!!*

Maybe things look bleak, maybe it seems it is too much...

But here is God’s message to Moses during the worst and hardest of times:

***I AM STILL GOD... I AM STILL HERE!***

He says the same thing to you today in your hard times.

Notice that God didn’t start bringing up Moses’ past

Only Moses’ **HERITAGE!**

That God was there for those before Moses, & God would be there for Moses too!

Also notice that Moses doesn't need to remind God of His promises, God brings it up!

You know, as the church – the body of Christ, we also have a great heritage, a legacy. God's promises are true & He remembers them & He wants you to know that!

Alisha and I always get excited when we see a rainbow, because we know that is a great reminder... **God keeps His promises!!**

There is something that is often missed in Exodus 3:6.

God wants you to be confident, not in yourself, but confident in Him!

He is God, He is in control, and He wants you to know that.

Many people ask: "Do you believe in life after death?"

Allow me to prove it to you...

**Exodus 3:6 – I Am the God of...**

And then God starts name dropping. He mentions all these people that used to live on earth, but now have passed away.

Yet God does not say: "I WAS the God of your father, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, etc, etc" God uses an ever-existing, eternal statement.

**Matthew 22:32** – Here Jesus actually quotes what we are reading today. Then Jesus continues on and says God is not the God of the dead, but He is the God of the living! Life goes on...

**John 11:25-26 – Jesus said: "I Am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?"**

**Acts 3:15 – Jesus is the AUTHOR of Life!**

You see, He is the Author! He wrote the book. As the Author, the one who is writing the book, He can do whatever He wants to, because it all belongs to Him!

**John 14:1-6 – Life in Christ does not end! It cannot be taken from you, and you cannot lose it. He is preparing a place for you & He is coming back for you!**

God tells Moses and use here that He doesn't forget His covenants, His promises, and He doesn't forget His people!

**Philippians 1:6 – "For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus."**

That doesn't sound like a God who gives up or lets go!

The last thing I want you to notice today, should change your whole life!

Take notice that God didn't talk about who Moses was, who Moses is, or who Moses was going to be...

**God's greatest revelation to Moses was not who Moses was,  
God's greatest revelation to Moses was:  
Who God is!**

Let me make sure you get this now...

God's greatest revelation to you, is not who you are,  
God's greatest revelation to you is:

Who God is!

John 14:6

"I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life.  
No one comes to the Father, except through Me."
